Operational Decision Making

- Capability in place with good adoption by BCC and across Bristol by partners
- Data is informing decision making across single and multi-agency meetings
- Shared understanding of risk and vulnerability in families

Strategic Capability

- Fully realised vision, utilised across BCC and Partners by 2019/20
 - Data embedded in procurement cycles
- Using evidence and evaluation to plan strategically and drive continuous improvement within the city

Think Family Database

Continued refinement of data model, agile development of new functionality

Predictive Risk Analysis

- Greater understanding of individual risk
- Identify organisation risk e.g. per school
 - Modelling support service design
 - Alert practitioners to risk

Risk of NEET	25 Feb 2020	88.00	This child is at risk of becoming NEET due to factors present in their Think Family, school attendance and educational attainment history (Think Family and educational attainment factors apply to the individual and/or their family).
Risk of Conduct Disorder	25 Feb 2020	94	This person has been flagged at risk as they meet 3 risk factors. These are derived from income deprivation, crime and ASB, substance misuse, domestic abuse and neglect within their families.
Risk of Child Criminal Exploitation	25 Feb 2020	50.000	This young person is vulnerable to Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE). They are supported by the Safer Options and Youth Offending Teams. They are linked to CCE-related Police reports; they are linked to people who are linked to County Lines- related Police reports; they are linked to Police intelligence relating to acquisitive crime; they are involved in criminality with people aged over 18; they have gone missing 16 times; they are linked to other young people who are also vulnerable to CCE and to people aged over 18 who are linked to CCE-related Police reports.

Risk of Neet Model



- Identify entrenched neets aged 17
- Understand their profile at younger age
- Model on risk factors
- Apply risk factors to current age group
- Identifies risk of neet cohort
- Broader and detailed analysis compared to current RONI models -

- Bring in health data on risk and vulnerability
- Develop ethics framework
- Focus on safeguarding leads in schools
